Partner rules



- 1. Take turns to speak. Do good listening when your partner is talking.
- 2. Write down what each person's ideas are.
- 3. Choose one idea to start with. Sometimes this is your idea, sometimes it will be your partners idea. This is good partner work.
- 4. Make a plan of what you will do first, next and then. Write it down and follow the plan.
- 5. Take turns to do things or decide which part you will do and which part your partner will do. Don't forget to share out the work equally!
- 6. Do the work.
- 7. Put it together.
- 8. Be proud and pleased at your finished work and that you did great partner working.
