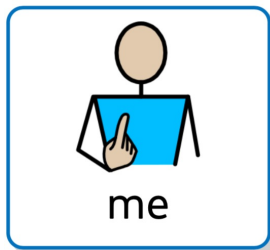


# Going to my new class in September

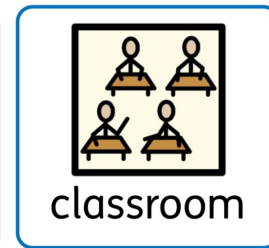
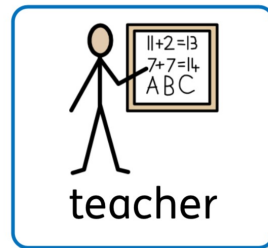
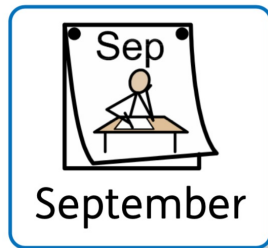
Usually, schools have a year that starts in September and goes through to the next July.

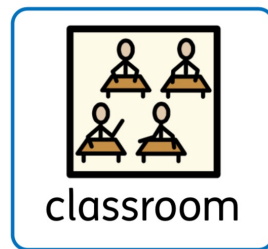
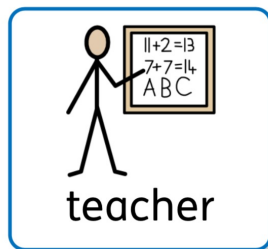
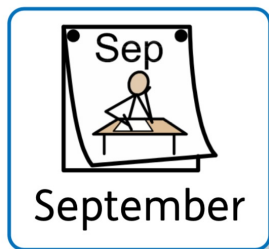
This means we have about 6 weeks off between one school year and the next. We don't go to school for all of August.
